Get the flu shot... not the flu!



Getting a yearly flu vaccine is an important way to protect yourself and others. It is recommended that all people 6 months and older get a flu vaccine each year.

Flu Shot Coverage

For those enrolled in the medical insurance plan, flu shots are covered 100% in-network as preventive care, at no cost to you.

Where to Get Your Flu Shot

You can receive a flu shot at:

- The Health Center
- Your primary care physician's office
- An in-network pharmacy
- A retail clinic
- An urgent care center
- A network walk-in clinic

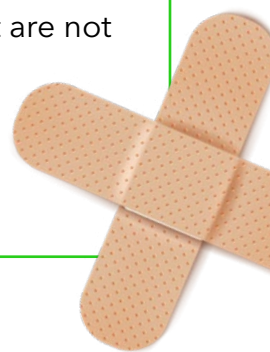
Billing Information

- **Retail Pharmacy:** Flu shots administered at an in-network pharmacy without a retail clinic should be billed through your prescription drug benefit.
- **Doctor's Office, Retail Clinic, or Urgent Care Center:** Flu shots administered by these provider types should be billed through your medical benefit.

Myth Buster!

You cannot get the flu from getting the flu vaccine. Flu vaccines that are administered with a needle are currently made in two ways:

1. With inactivated flu vaccine viruses that are not infectious, **or**
2. With no flu vaccine viruses at all
